Community Energy Efficiency Program Request for Proposals

Overview

The Washington State University (WSU) Energy Program invites proposals from qualified organizations to deliver **residential decarbonization services** across Washington State. Selected partners must be prepared to begin service delivery by **early 2026**.

Focus Areas

Proposals should include the following priorities:

• Home Electrification

Replace fossil fuel-based space and water heating systems with high-efficiency electric alternatives.

- Hard-to-Reach Populations, including:
 - Low- to moderate-income households
 - Those with non-utility fuels (e.g., oil, propane, wood)
 - Market rate rentals
 - o Rural or other areas with limited program delivery infrastructure

Funding Availability

WSU Energy Program will award up to eight grants ranging from **\$250,000 to \$1.1 million**

Priority Consideration

Preference will be given to proposals that:

- Are led by community-based or nonprofit organizations
- Serve areas not previously reached by Clean Energy Equity Program (CEEP) funding
- Demonstrate scalability and long-term sustainability
