Accounts required for school districts to submit applications

- Current registration with the federal System for Award Management (SAM):
 - In April 2022, the unique entity identifier used by the federal government changed from the DUNS Number to the Unique Entity ID.
 - The Unique Entity ID is assigned by SAM.gov.
 - Visit <u>SAM.gov</u> to check the status of your organization's SAM registration.
- Access to Grants.gov:
 - Register with <u>Grants.gov</u> well ahead of the deadline—this process can take a month or more.
