HERS is a nationally-recognized rating certification program and it is a prerequisite for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) ENERGY STAR®, Indoor airPLUS®, and other certification programs. - Fundamentals of residential building science
- RESNET® standards and procedures
- Floor plan take offs and calculators
- Use of REM/Rate® and Ekotrope® modeling tools
- Diagnostic tools and testing
- Introduction to applicable software
- An overview of the many home energy certification programs available for certified raters so that they can consider offering more options to their clients.



The training will include:

Virtual class split into multiple mandatory session blocks, hosted by the WSU Energy Program October 17-28 M-F 9AM- noon Pacific Time ; a computer with REM/Rate® (PC only) or Ekotrope is required (free trial subscriptions are available for this). Classes will be 8AM-4PM Pacific Time.
